Meeting Medicare's criteria for a power mobility device (PMD) requires a patient to have at least one impairment with mobility-related activities of daily living (MRADL) inside the home, such as feeding, dressing, grooming, bathing, and toileting.

## Step 1: We prescreen the patient's mobility needs

- Medicare requires a face-to-face mobility exam with a treating practitioner and documentation of findings

- You write the prescription and provide supporting documentation
